ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Norfolk Christian Schools operates on a semester system with four nine-week quarters over the course of a year. We utilize an A/B eight-block schedule where eight classes are taught over a two day (A/B Day) period, four blocks each day. MID-YEAR grades are automatically sent to all colleges in January; FINAL TRANSCRIPTS will be sent to each student's final choice college in late June.

ACT INFORMATION

Of the 78 students in the Class of 2020, only 9 students (11%) chose to take the ACT. The middle-50% range was 25-28 for a best-test composite score.
